Nate Russell's musical journey in the UK as an early teenager was influenced heavily by his mum's extensive record collection, which included the likes of the Beatles, Guns N Roses, the Who and Cream. He was fortunate to watch Oasis live at Knebworth Festival in 1996, and was inspired to pick up the guitar by the iconic band at the influential age of 15.

Nate's journey brought him to Australia as a backpacker in 2009, when he travelled extensively up and down the East Coast busking his way through Sydney, Newcastle, Gold Coast, Brisbane and the Whitsundays.

Returning to the Uk, Nate formed the band Mile Wide Stride(MWS) The group wrote and performed their own music, touring around the country. Mile Wide Stride performed at the Triumph Live festival and while supporting Reef. Mile Wide Stride were noticed by UB40, who asked MWS to tour with them as support. After a successful tour in 2013, Nate secured Brian Travers (founding member of UB40) and his horn section to perform on a few MWS songs.

After traveling to Alabama in the USA, Nate was again influenced, by his father-in- law's record collection, which include the like of Willie Nelson, Johnny Cash and Waylon Jennings

After returning to Australia in January 2016, Nate and Jenny settled in Redcliffe, and have brought son Jagger and Daughter Lilyrose into the world.

Nate has been back writing music for 2 years, and is eagerly awaiting the release of his first Australian Album, North of the Border, due early 2021.
